## **Organization of Report**

This document consists of five main sections. They include an introduction, a survey questions section, a methods section, key findings, and a conclusion. Results for the 2005 Local Ordinance Survey are located in Appendix B of this document.

## **Introduction**

In September, 2005, The Wyoming Survey and Analysis Center (WYSAC) conducted the second iteration of the Local Ordinance Survey for the Wyoming Department of Health (WDH) Substance Abuse Division (SAD). WDH Tobacco Prevention and Control Program conducted the first iteration of the Local Ordinance Survey for SAD in 2001. For both iterations, surveys were mailed to local government officials in all incorporated towns within Wyoming<sup>1</sup>. In both 2001 and 2005, surveys were sent to the same 97 municipalities. Completed surveys were returned in one of three ways: by mail, by fax, or by telephone. A copy of the 2005 Local Ordinance Surveys are located in Appendix A of this document.

## **Survey Questions**

Survey questions pertained to the existence of tobacco-related ordinances within each municipality. For purposes of analysis, the two versions of the survey were considered comparable. The first five questions in the 2001 Local Ordinance Survey were also asked in the 2005 Local Ordinance Survey. The 2005 survey, however,

contained one additional question: “Does your town have a local ordinance regulating smoking in public places or workplaces?” If the respondents in 2005 answered yes to this additional question, they were then asked to provide the appropriate ordinance number and the date the ordinance was last updated.

Both the 2001 and the 2005 Local Ordinance Surveys asked the following five questions:

1. Does your town have a specific ordinance covering sales of tobacco to minors?
2. Does your town have a specific ordinance for possession, use, and/or purchase of tobacco by minors?
3. Does your town have a specific ordinance covering tobacco product placement?
4. Does your town have a specific ordinance covering tobacco licensing?
5. Does your town have any other ordinances relating to tobacco?

## **Methods**

Results from the 2005 Local Ordinance Survey were analyzed using the statistical analysis software program SPSS, version 13.0. For the 2001 dataset, 81 of the 97 towns in the 2001 survey were included in the analysis. The 13 towns that did not return surveys and the three towns with no tobacco sales were counted as missing data. For the 2005 dataset, all 85 of the 97 towns with returned surveys were included in the analysis. The 12 towns not returning the surveys were counted as missing data.

The analysis was conducted using seven tobacco ordinance variables. Six variables corresponded to the questions on the Local Ordinance Surveys. These variables were:

1. Sales to minors ordinance

2. Possession by minors ordinance
3. Product placement ordinance
4. Tobacco licensing ordinance
5. Other tobacco ordinances
6. Public or workplace ordinance (2005 survey only)

The seventh variable was a collapsed variable: the “any tobacco ordinance” variable.

This variable was created to separate towns with no tobacco ordinances from towns with at least one tobacco ordinance.

Town populations were placed into one of three categories: low, medium, and high. Towns designated as low had fewer than 1,000 people living in them. Towns designated as medium had populations between 1,000 and 9,999, and a town with a high population had more than 10,000 individuals.

Towns were also assigned to one of the regions identified in the Wyoming Adult Tobacco Survey. These five regions are:

Region 1: Converse, Goshen, Laramie, Niobara, and Platte Counties

Region 2: Albany, Carbon, and Natrona Counties

Region 3: Campbell, Crook, Johnson, Sheridan, and Weston Counties

Region 4: Big Horn, Fremont, Hot Springs, Park, Teton, and Washakie Counties

Region 5: Lincoln, Sublette, Sweetwater, and Uinta Counties

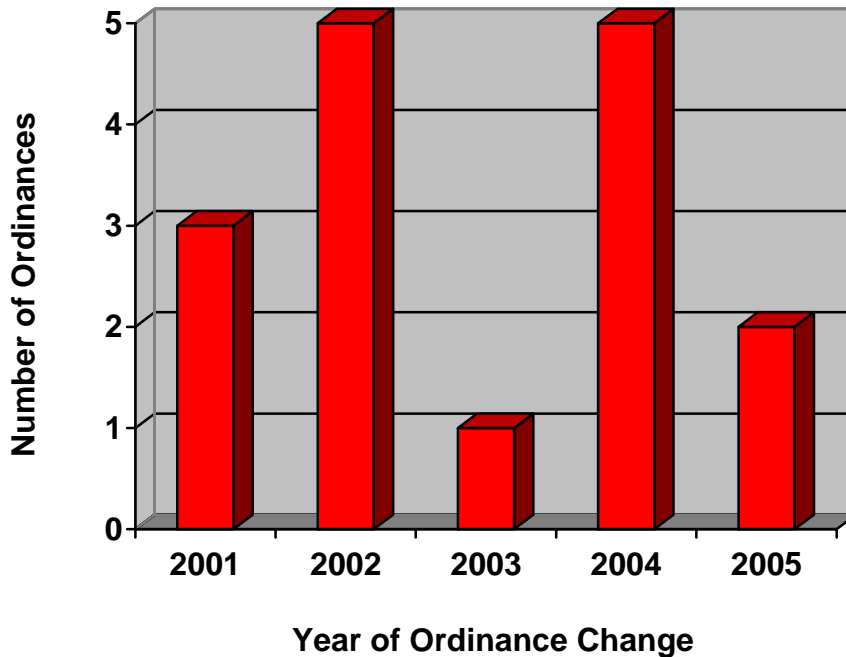
## **Key Findings**

### **Survey Completion Rates**

In 2001 and 2005, the Wyoming Association of Municipalities listed 97 towns (municipalities) in its membership. All 97 municipalities were asked to complete the Local Ordinance Survey. Of the 97 towns, 81 (83.5%) completed and returned the survey, 3 (3.0%) reported that no establishment in their town sold tobacco, and 13 (13.4%) either could not be contacted or did not return the survey. In 2005, the same 97 towns were contacted and asked to complete the 2005 version of the Local Ordinance Survey. Of the 97 towns, 85 (87.6%) completed and returned the survey and twelve (12.4%) either could not be contacted or did not return the survey. No government officials reported that establishments in their town did not sell tobacco products. Only five towns did not return a survey in both 2001 and 2005. These towns are Albin, Bairoil, Cowley, Deaver, and Granger.

### **Updated Ordinances**

The following 14 towns reported updating one or more of their tobacco-related ordinances between 2001 and 2005: Alpine, Basin, Buffalo, Cheyenne, Cody, Cowley, Dubois, Gillette, Greybull, Kaycee, Laramie, Saratoga, Thermopolis, and Van Tassell. Two municipalities, Buffalo and Dubois, updated ordinances in two different years. Therefore, 16 tobacco ordinances were updated between 2001 and 2005. Figure 1 shows the frequency of updates by year from 2001 to 2005. Information detailing which ordinances were updated can be found in the 2005 Local Ordinance Survey in Appendix B.

Of the 85 surveys completed and returned in 2005, 12 (14.1%) towns reported that they had an ordinance regulating smoking in public or work places. The towns are Buffalo, Casper, Cheyenne, Diamondville, Dubois, Elk Mountain, Gillette, Green River, Jackson, Lander, Laramie, and Pine Bluffs.

**2005 Ordinances by Population and Region**

Of the 85 towns submitting data for 2005, 50 (58.8%) met the designation for low population, 27 (31.8%) met the designation for medium population, and 8 (9.4%) were designated as high population. Although not statistically significant, population category appeared to co-vary with ordinances: larger communities tended more often to have tobacco ordinances. Table 1 shows the number of towns within each population category

and the *number* (N) and *percentage* (%) of towns, by population category, that reported having at least one tobacco ordinance *of any type*. A town was considered to have “any” tobacco ordinance if it reported having at least one of the ordinances specified on the Local Ordinance Surveys.

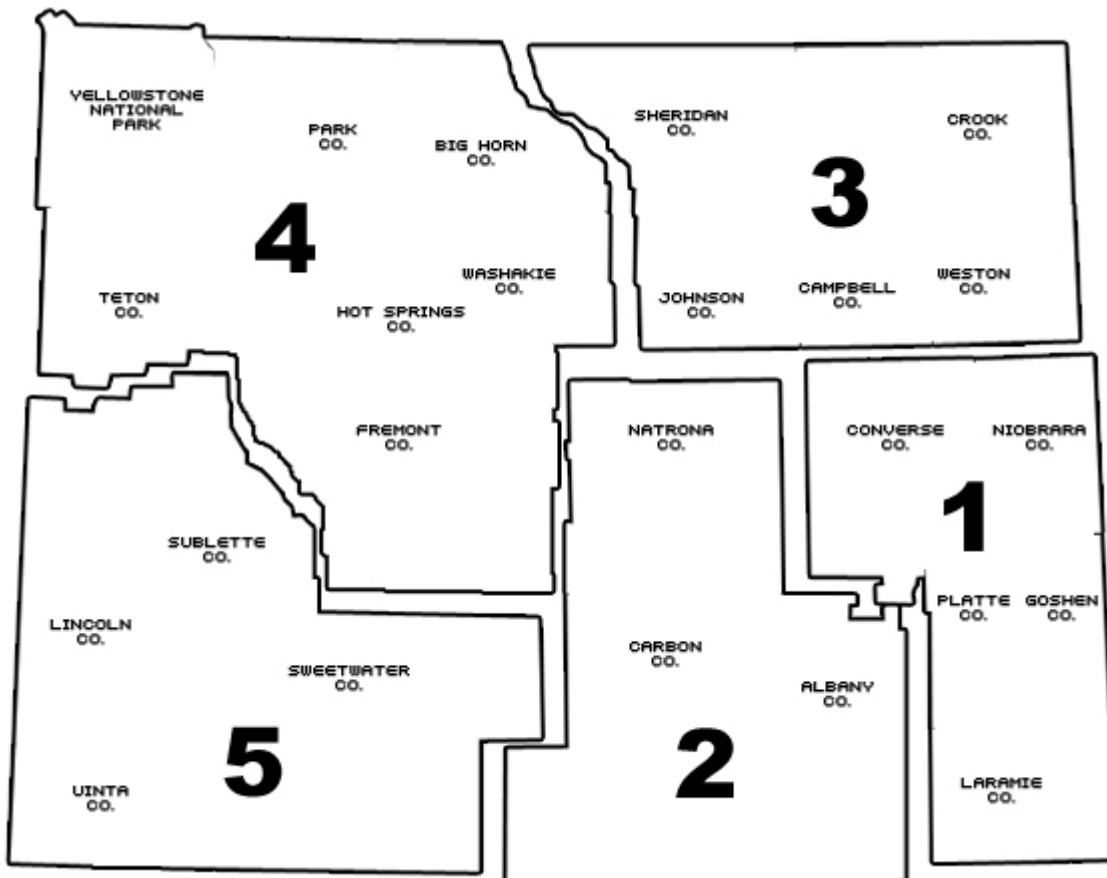
A similar analysis was conducted for regions of the state. Table 2 shows the number of towns in each region and the *number* (N) and *percentage* (%) of towns, within region, that reported having at least one tobacco ordinance *of any type*. Figure 2 is a geographical representation of which counties fall into which region. Although the differences among regions were not statistically significant, Region 5 reported the highest percentage of towns with tobacco ordinances (71.4%), and Region 1 reported the lowest percentage of towns with tobacco ordinances (42.1%). Regions 2, 3, 4, and 5 all had a greater number of towns with tobacco ordinances than of towns without ordinances.

### Comparison of Ordinance Rates between 2001 and 2005

Table 3 provides a summary of the variables (the six variables taken directly from the questions on the 2001 and the 2005 Local Ordinance Surveys and the one collapsed “any tobacco ordinance” variable. Space constraints required abbreviated ordinance labels. Following are the abbreviations corresponding with the appropriate ordinance:

1. Sales = Sales to Minors
2. Possess = Possession by Minors
3. Product = Product Placement
4. License = Tobacco Licensing
5. Other = Other Tobacco Ordinances
6. Places = Public or Workplaces
7. Any = Any Tobacco Ordinances

This table shows both the *number* (N) and *percentage* (%) of towns with ordinances. The final row in Table 3 provides the percent change for all seven variables. No data are provided under the column, “Place” in 2001 because that item was not included in the 2001 survey.

### Conclusions

The number of tobacco ordinances in Wyoming has increased from 2001 to 2005. The percentage of towns with “any tobacco ordinance” rose from 44.4% in 2001 to 57.6% in 2005, an increase of 13.2%. With the exception of “other ordinances,” the number and percentage of all item-specific ordinances increased from 2001 to 2005. One noteworthy finding is the increase, from 2001 to 2005, in ordinances specifically addressing tobacco sales to minors. This 11.7% increase may be the result of the Synar Amendment and Wyoming’s efforts in support of the amendment (e.g., Reward and Reminder, Got ID?). Results from the Synar Compliance Study indicate that tobacco sales to minors have decreased from 55% in 1999 to 7% in 2005. This reduction in sales suggests that when ordinances prohibiting sales to minors are combined with enforcement of the Synar Amendment, there is a significant impact on the sale of tobacco to minors.

Another noteworthy finding is the decrease in “other tobacco ordinances” from 2001 to 2005.” This decrease may have been the result of the additional question on the 2005 survey: “Did the municipality have an ordinance on tobacco use in public or workplaces?” Towns with an ordinance prohibiting tobacco in public or workplaces would have listed this ordinance under “other tobacco ordinances” in 2001 and under “public or workplaces ordinances” in 2005. As a result, the “other” ordinances reported in 2001 included ordinances on tobacco use in public or workplaces while the “other” category in 2005 did not.

Overall, if the existence of tobacco ordinances is an indicator of the importance local towns and communities place on tobacco-related issues, then monitoring and tracking changes in the number of local tobacco ordinances is an important assessment for monitoring community awareness and beliefs.
